#### **SURVEY 2006**

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SURVEY 2006 seeks Outsider art by self-taught artists with mental disabilities. The exhibit will present Outsider art - reflecting the artist's own ideas and visions disregarding mainstream artistic values and historical art movements.

Outsider artists are invited to submit an application with examples of their art as slides, photographs or digital prints to be considered for SURVEY 2006.

# SPONSORING ORGANIZATION

HAI (Hospital Audiences, Inc., www.hospaud.org) is a nonprofit arts organization that provides access to the arts for culturally isolated people. The Gallery at HAI is an outgrowth of the HAI Arts Workshop Program that brings participatory arts to community programs for people with mental disabilities. Developed from the HAI Workshop Program, HAI has exhibited art by people with mental disabilities for over twenty years. Outsider Artists of HAI are a remarkable group of self-taught artists who were discovered in the HAI Workshop Program and have become known as quintessential late twentieth/early twenty-first century American Outsider artists.

### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Entry is open to Outsider artists with mental disabilities and mental health consumers / service users over the age of 18.

A maximum of 5 examples (slides, photos, digital prints) of an artist's work per individual application may be submitted for jurying.

Actual art should not be sent unless accepted into the exhibit.

Eligible art includes paintings, drawings, collages or mixed media in 2 or 3 dimensions.

Works of art in 2 dimensions may be no larger than a combined 130 inches in length, width and depth and must conform to United Parcel Service (UPS) shipping guidelines for standard packages. Any 3 dimensional art selected for the exhibit must be transported at the artist's expense. It will be requested that all selected art be sent unframed.

All entries must be available for sale. Entrant must designate a full retail sale price no higher than \$2,000. The Gallery at HAI will retain a commission of 35% on all sales.

Exhibiting artist will be identified as a person with a mental disability or as a mental health consumer / service user unless artist elects to have their art exhibited anonymously without their name. Biographies are required to verify the artist's eligibility for this exhibit. With artist's permission, biographical information (with names or anonymously) will be included in a catalog accompanying the exhibit.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

Submissions for jurying may be slides, photographs or digital prints (8.5" x 11"). No discs.

SURVEY 2006 expects the accepted submissions will be the same works provided for exhibit.

Submissions must be labeled with the artist's name, dimensions of the work, title, and media.

All slides, photographs or digital prints will be retained by The Gallery.

A nonrefundable application fee of \$10 and a stamped, self-addressed envelope must accompany the application.

Submissions accepted for exhibition will be requested after the selection process.

Application does not guarantee acceptance.
